


A TASTE OF PORTLAND "AMERICA'S FOODIEST SMALL TOWN"

- It's no coincidence that Bon Appétit magazine recently crowned Portland "America's Foodiest Small Town" because there's so much here to please the palate. You will have a chance to stroll through the Old Port, sampling your way through various restaurants and shops offering an array of delectable items that reflect Portland's distinct cuisine.
- Your guided walking tour will begin in town and carve a path through the historic streets of the Old Port and have you meandering along the waterfront, an area that 100 years ago was home to canneries, factories and textile mills. Today, this warehouse district has been revitalized with dozens of quaint restaurants, coffee houses, bakeries and shops selling gourmet merchandise.
- To satisfy your curiosity, your guide will introduce you to several of the finest Old Port venues to sample their wares. While the exact stores and restaurants may vary, you can be sure that the items will be heavily influenced by what's fresh and indicative of the local cuisine. Some of these Maine-inspired foods & beverages include Maine lobster, New England chowder, fresh-baked pastries, local seasonal craft beer and home made chips made from Maine potatoes

- Guests will be led by foot through the quaint streets of the Old Port where they will have an opportunity to visit four local Maine pubs where they will sample some of Maine's most popular and unique local and regional craft beers.
- On this tour, participants will be treated to a selection of beers brewed in Maine, including IPA's fruit beers, stouts, unique small batch kegs and more.
- Guests will learn from local bartenders & brew masters where the beers are brewed, how they are brewed and what the most popular Maine Craft Breweries are brewing now.
- There will be ample time to ask questions about each selection and learn how each beer is brewed and about the Maine brewers who brew them. A must do for any beer lover!
- Tastings at the various stops may include a giant Bavarian pretzel, house made potato chips and bar snacks.
